

## A5 YACHT OFFSHORE COURSES

All marks to starboard UNLESS OTHERWISE INDICATED (P). All distances are approximate.

### Longitude Race (OS1)

Each boat will be allocated a longitude to the east to which they must sail. The resulting course length for each boat will be determined by its PHS handicap applied as a Distance Correction Factor (DCF). Longitudes will be published on the MYC website 3 hours prior to the start.

The race results will be determined by elapsed time. Boats should take a timestamped photo of their GPS position when on or east of their allocated longitude.

1. Start Manly
2. Any point east of the individually allocated longitude.
3. Finish Manly

### Shellharbour Race (OS2)

1. Start – transit from North Head to Hornby Light
2. Finish – a line bearing 090 degrees true from the northern breakwater at the entrance to Shellharbour Marina.

Boats are reminded to record their finish times and promptly report them to the Race Officer.

Boats are also reminded that, for the Shellharbour Race, if they have a genuine belief that they will not be able to sail to the finish by 1900, they will be allowed to record their time and location by taking a timestamped photo of their GPS position and then motor to the destination.

### Pittwater Race (OS3)

1. Start Manly
2. Junction Buoy (P)
3. Finish – a line bearing 270 degrees true from the finishing tower located ashore at the Royal Motor Yacht Club.
