ORGANISING AUTHORITY MANLY YACHT CLUB

Invitation

The Club Championships are the premiere series at Manly Yacht Club. The series comprises 10 scratch start races around the sound, including 4 of the Combined Clubs Sunday Series races. See if you can sail to your handicap and become the season Club Champion. Also race for the coveted Bob Greene Trophy or the Davis Cup by being the fastest boat around the course in your division.

1. Rules

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and any General Conditions of Racing as defined by the Organising Authority, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions which are also considered part of the rules.
- 1.2 The Organising Authority (OA) for this series is Manly Yacht Club (MYC).
- 1.3 Races from the Combined Clubs Sunday Series are included in this series, which may have a different Organising Authority for the purpose of conducting those races.
- 1.4 The Sailing Instructions will be those of the Combined Clubs Sunday Series, other than as modified by this NOR.
- 1.5 MYC may amend this Notice of Race. Amendments will be published on the Official Notice Board on the MYC website www.myc.org.au/notice-board/.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 A division must be constituted by a minimum of four yachts.
- 2.2 Yachts may only compete in the Club Championships using the nominated helm(s). Written notice of changes to helm may be considered by the Race Director.

3. Fees

- 3.1 Entry fees are listed in Section 5.1, Racing Fees in the MYC Handbook.
- 3.2 The entry fee includes the Manly Sprint Series and all Combined Club Sunday Series races, even those not included in this point score.

4. Schedule

- 4.1 The schedule of race days is shown in Section 5.8 MYC Calendar.
- 4.2 There is 1 TCF Race scheduled for each division per day.
- 4.3 For information, races 1, 2, 3 and 9 of this series will be the same as Combined Clubs Sunday Series passage races 1, 5, 6 and 10.

5. Divisions and Handicaps

- 5.1 The following divisions will be sailed:
 - Yachts Division 1 for yachts with spinnaker and PHS handicap.
 - Yachts Division 2 for yachts with and without spinnaker and PHS handicap.

6. Scoring

- 6.1 The PHS Handicap system will be used to score a boat's result and adjust her handicap.
- 6.2 The number of races scheduled for the series is shown in Section 5.8 MYC Calendar.
- 6.3 The number of races required to constitute a series will be 4 less than the number of races scheduled in the series
- 6.4 When 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her series scores excluding her worst 2 scores.
- 6.5 When fewer than 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her series scores excluding her worst 1 score.

7. Prizes

- 7.1 Prizes will be awarded on the deck at the end of the day's racing. All prizes not immediately accepted by competitors or their representatives will be redrawn.
- 7.2 Grand Prizes, where applicable, will be drawn from the "barrel" on the last day of racing in the series.

8. Further Information

8.1 A BBQ, presentation and get together will be held on the MYC balcony after racing.
