

# YACHT MANLY SPRINT SERIES – NOR

## ORGANISING AUTHORITY MANLY YACHT CLUB

### Invitation

Manly Yacht Club invites yachts to participate in up to 2 Sundays of racing, consisting of up to 3 short, sharp windward/return races per day. A great way to hone your skills, this fun regatta is followed by a prizegiving, food and frivolities on the deck of MYC, with a grand prize drawn from the barrel on the final day of racing.

### 1. Rules

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and any General Conditions of Racing as defined by the Organising Authority, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions which are also considered part of the rules.
- 1.2 The Organising Authority (OA) for this series is Manly Yacht Club (MYC).
- 1.3 Races from the Combined Clubs Sunday Series are included in this series, which may have a different Organising Authority for the purpose of conducting those races.
- 1.4 The Sailing Instructions will be those of the Combined Clubs Sunday, other than as modified by this NOR.
- 1.5 MYC may amend this Notice of Race. Amendments will be published on the Official Notice Board on the MYC website [www.myc.org.au/notice-board/](http://www.myc.org.au/notice-board/).

### 2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 A division must be constituted by a minimum of four yachts.

### 3. Fees

- 3.1 Entry fees are listed in Section 5.1, Racing Fees in the MYC Handbook.

### 4. Schedule

- 4.1 The schedule of races is shown in Section 5.8 MYC Calendar.
- 4.2 For information, all races in this series are included in the Combined Clubs Sunday Series, races 2, 3, 4, 7, 8, & 9.

### 5. Divisions and Handicaps

- 5.1 The following divisions will be sailed:
  - Yachts - Division 1 for yachts with spinnaker and PHS handicap.
  - Yachts - Division 2 for yachts with and without spinnaker and PHS handicap.

### 6. Scoring

- 6.1 The PHS Handicap system will be used to score a boat's result and adjust her handicap.
- 6.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores with no excluded scores.
- 6.3 The number of races required to constitute a series is 3.

### 7. Prizes

- 7.1 Prizes will be awarded on the deck at the end of the day's racing. All prizes not immediately accepted by competitors or their representatives will be redrawn.
- 7.2 Grand Prizes, where applicable, will be drawn from the "barrel" on the last day of racing in the series.

### 8. Further Information

- 8.1 A BBQ and presentation will be held on the MYC balcony after racing.
