

YACHT WINTER SERIES – NOR

ORGANISING AUTHORITY MANLY YACHT CLUB

Invitation

An invitation is extended by Manly Yacht Club, to compete in a Winter Series around the harbour on Sunday afternoons for yachts between 6m and 20m. The series gives skippers and crews the experience to transition from casual twilight racing to staggered daylight starts before progressing to the scratch starts of the more competitive Club Championships. Nominate your intention to fly a kite or not. This race format is Pursuit TCF. Each boat has an individual allocated start time and results are determined based on corrected time.

1. Rules

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the General Conditions of Racing as defined by Section 7 of the MYC Handbook, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions which are also considered part of the rules.
- 1.2 The Organising Authority may amend this Notice of Race. Amendments will be published on the Official Notice Board on the MYC website www.myc.org.au/notice-board/.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Entry is open to mono hull sailing yachts with length overall from 6m to 20m or at the Race Committee's discretion.
- 2.2 Boats must hold a Category 7 AS Equipment Audit Form.

3. Fees

- 3.1 Entry fees are listed in Section 5.1, Racing Fees in the MYC Handbook.

4. Schedule

- 4.1 The schedule of race days is shown in Section 5.8 MYC Calendar.
- 4.2 The following classes/divisions will be sailed:
 - Yachts – Division 1
 - Yachts – Division 2
- 4.3 There is 1 Pursuit TCF Race scheduled for each division per day.

5. Racing Area

- 5.1 Racing will be conducted within Sydney Harbour.

6. Prizes

- 6.1 Prizes will be awarded on the deck at the end of the day's racing. All prizes not immediately accepted by competitors or their representatives will be redrawn.
- 6.2 Grand Prizes, where applicable, will be drawn from the "barrel" on the last day of racing in the series.

7. Further Information

- 7.1 A BBQ and presentation will be held on the MYC balcony after racing.
