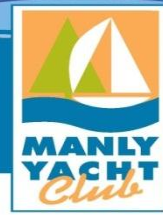


MYC NEWS

AUDIT DAY is SATURDAY 1st SEPTEMBER

Running downwind at high speed towards us is the Audit day for MYC boats. To avoid catastrophes large or small we should all be prepared for the day by ensuring all the requirements for our particular audit Category have been met. This of course includes not only having sufficient and the right equipment ready on board but also those pieces requiring it, to be "in date".

Audit forms should be completed in duplicate and both forms returned to the MYC office at least one week before the inspection day.

Since last year's audit there have been several changes to the requirements for all categories. This year the main changes are concerned with the Personal Flotation Devices > (Rule 5.01 Amendment 9 - Incorporating Amendments 3 and 8).

This amended new rule affects both Cat 4 and Cat 7 particularly. Check out the YA website for all the necessary information, www.yachting.org.au. For Cat 4 > Rule 3.25.5 is included this year.

You will also find that the new audit forms have included in them the new requirements so please make sure that you are fully aware of what is required before turning up for

inspection and failing because your boat did not conform. Any doubts please check with one of the auditors. If you are a current member of MYC you should have already received your Audit forms which accompanied you new Club Handbook.

The auditor's job is purely to help the owner by checking and confirming that the boat has the correct safety equipment and that it is correctly maintained and stowed. The safety of the boat and her crew is the "sole and inescapable responsibility of the owner" > Rule 1.02.

Audit inspections will be carried out at the usual venues, Davis Marina for all categories and MYC for Cat 7 only. The times for inspections will commence at 9.00am and carry through until 12 noon so please make sure you arrange to be at your chosen venue between those hours. There will be no times allocated but boats will be inspected in the order in which they attend, first in first served! You will see on page 39 of the new MYC Handbook 2012-2013 that a fee of \$20 can be charged for boats not checked on the allocated day.

When you present your boat once again make sure that all the necessary gear is laid out, in good condition, "in-date" and ready for checking. This saves confusion and time and also helps the Auditors who are volunteers and give up their time to assist in carrying out the audits.

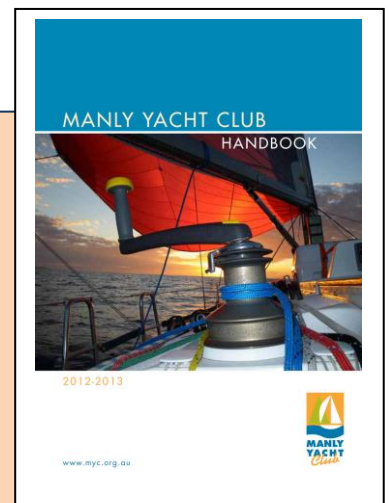

Helping to organise the racing is part of the fun of racing! So please nominate some days to help out with the race committee and/or shop. Don't worry if you don't have experience - you can either learn on the day or you can attend one of our race officer training courses (dates to be advised).

Some of our boats have started the new season already and congratulations are due to Copernicus for her ORCi win in the Southport race. I was lucky enough to be on board for the race and it was a great downhill ride. Also the weather gods were kind for our Winter series and all races completed with good winds and fine weather. TenSixty won the div 1 point score and Euphoria topped the big div 2! However the winter series grand prize is drawn from the barrel with the number of entries proportional to your performances. Esra Tew was the lucky yacht to walk away with the \$500 cocktail party from our generous sponsor - The Space bar and spa in Manly!

I guess while we are handing out congratulations, then as a club we should extend our support to our Olympic sailors, who have been doing us proud both in the medals and out of them. My only lament is how badly the sailing has been covered in the media. Ken has been tweaking the website and it is looking better than ever, together with the handbook it forms an invaluable source of all information about the club. It is also now possible to enter and pay for your race entry via the website, which will save our volunteers a lot of paperwork and improve the speed and accuracy of publishing entries, start times and results.

Once you have entered your boat details, you can enter an series with a few clicks, including races/regattas at other clubs (eg SHR). If you have already entered one of these regattas then your boat details are probably already online. So if possible please use the online entry system.

Equipment audit day is Saturday 1st of September and the cat 4/7 forms are included. Please have all your equipment in date alaid out so that it can be checked efficiently and with no waste of time. Don't forget to check the expiry dates of flares, fire extinguishers and items in your first aid kits. Also Sunday 26th August is our AMS measurement day, give me a call on 0417786631 if you want to get measured or just to ask what this AMS stuff is all about.

Our race season starts on the 2nd of September with the first marathon race, which is now part of it's own 2 race series. Entry is free to all boats entered in another MYC Sunday series, so there is no excuse for not coming out for a grand sail around the harbour (unless of course you didn't check your flairs. didn't leave your gear laid out to be checked efficiently and didn't pass your safety inspection!)

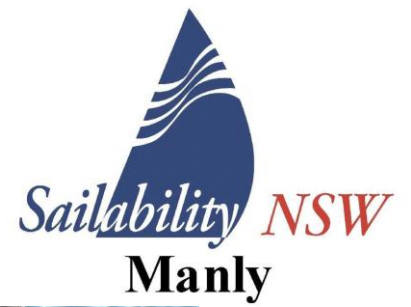

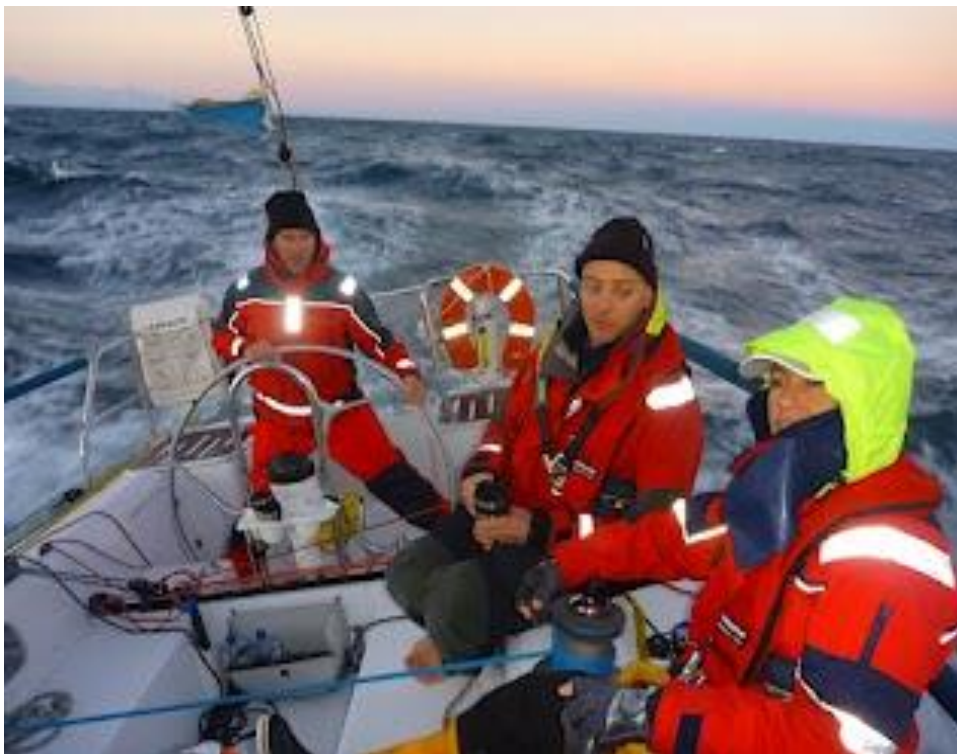

The second morning of the race saw Copernicus power reaching at 10-12 knots off Port Macquarie in 25+ knots of westerly with a full main and No.2 headsail. We had jumped to the lead in ORCi Div 2 and were just a few miles behind some 45-footers. It was a cool morning but nowhere near as cold as this race normally is.



With the new 0.9oz assy pulling hard we were reaching at a steady 12 knots (I know the speedo says only 9 but trust me) as it warmed up and wind backed to the south-west and moderated. A special prize to anyone who can guess why the brace is cross-sheeted to leeward. Hint: it involves a bald man and a pot of winch grease. By this time we were off Smoky Cape and running into some heavy southerly current but still ahead of our main rivals.



As you can guess by the body language we had the race sewn up as we ran under fractional spinnaker to the Qld border. That's Cape Byron in the background, with no other boat in sight.

It didn't last long as we parked off the Gold Coast and the backmarkers came flying home. After finally crossing the finish line we had a few anxious hours waiting to see if love and War could sail the last 18 miles in two hours.

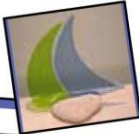
