It will be a great learning exercise and a worthwhile base for progressing your competence to run our various races.

If any damage to any equipment is noticed, please make sure it is reported, so that the item can be repaired before the following sailing day. This also refers to any boat, or its equipment, the hoists, or the trolleys.

If anything needs fixing, please report it when it happens, so that repairs can be made.
