

The 2017-20 Racing Rules of Sailing come into effect from 1 January 2017.

Changes are marked with a side bar, Australian Sailing's Prescriptions are identified in colour and Rules are linked allowing easy navigation. The Racing Rules of Sailing are available at no cost and have no restrictions on printing.

The **Special Regulations for 2017** will be published in near future and do not come into effect until **1 July 2017**. These will be published in a similar format and will be available free of charge on the Australian Sailing website.

HISTORY – IS IT KAREN OR IS IT JULIE?





KAREN

Karen first raced at Manly Yacht Club in the 1960s. Her first owner, Dave Tristram, named her after a beautiful young woman he saw emerging from the surf. It turned out she was his daughter but it took his friend Ted Lacey to recognise her.

Karen, the yacht, was one of the first of the "Julie Class" and the design was based on one by the well-known Dutch yacht designer Van Der Stadt. Three "Julies" were built by Ian Treharne and Dave Linton at Manly Boatshed (Trehane's), around 1960. Ian called his yacht Julie, after his daughter, which gave rise to the name of the class. One Julie was round bilge and the other two were hard chined for plywood construction. Dave Linton, the shipwright, was the same Dave Linton who had built Eos with Tom Flower in the mid

Karen is 21ft long and 6ft wide and she sailed really well.

The Club Newsletter dated September 1969 lists Karen as coming first and second in a three-race event with one race being cancelled. The same Newsletter welcomed Ian Treharne with his Julie and speculated that with three Julies there should be some interesting races.

Gene Scott (MYC's longest serving President) bought Karen from Dave Treharne, in the late 1970s and used her to teach his family to sail. He is very enthusiastic about her sailing ability and suitability as a small family yacht.

Sorry Gene, couldn't resist ... Ed

He went on to buy an Endeavour 24. Then by 1994 he had a Soling Felix, an Olympic class yacht; the 2000 Sydney Olympics were in sight. Finally he bought Aussie Rules in 2004, a Cavalier 975, which bore the sail number MYC1.

Peter McDonald, shipwright and long-term club member, bought Karen from Gene Scott and after substantial restoration work including a new taller mast and deck, raced her at MYC. His main rival, and the boat to beat, was Rumours, a Swanson Dart, with a big rig, which was sailed very efficiently by Bruce and Pam Davis. However Peter never succeeded in beating Rumours.

Karen is representative of the small yachts that became popular at the club, when the intrepid sailors of the 14ft skiffs decided to sail something with a little bit more comfort and the ability to take the family out for a sail.

Karen is still around today. She is moored in Mosman Bay.





The first piece of silverware for 2016/17 season has been contested and won with the AVOKA/deVita Spring Point Score being awarded to Garth Riley onboard 2Cheeks with Gordon Lacey (Fragile) 2nd and Cameron Wall (SqWall) 3rd. It was a very close finish with 1.2 points separating 1st & 2nd and only .8 of a point separating 3rd 7 4th, sorry Geoff. Garth sailed really well and consistency paid off in the end, well done for at least keeping Gordon away from the Cup this time.

On Dec. 3rd the Laser fleet kicked off the first of 4 Micro Regatta's this season (16 heats), which was sailed in great conditions with a 8-12kn Nor Easter. After the first 4 heats Ed Wray (Serenity Now) and Iain Cameron (Seanile), are top of the table with 10 points each followed really closely with defending champion Ian Saunders (Salty Dog) in 3rd.

On Nov. 25-26th the NSW State Laser Championships was held at Georges River SC, and Manly sent 4 boats, which was a great effort. Romy Saunders (Sirije), sailed really consistently in the 4.7 Fleet and came 16th overall which was a great effort. In the Radial Fleet, Marcus James picked up a 32nd in a tough fleet of over 50 boats. In the Standard Fleet Ian Saunders (Salty Dog) and Garth Riley (2Cheeks) picked up 19th and 24th respectively. Well done, Team Manly.



PEPPER TREE WINES

The Pepper Tree Club Championship for 2016/17 continues to be very competitive for the top 6 boats however Iain Cameron (Seanile), has jumped out in front with some copybook Laser sailing with three 1st's and a 2nd in the last four races. There is talk around the deck that he can't be caught but there is a long way to go yet. Ian Saunders (Salty Dog), in 2nd with Phil Reid (Sin Sceal Eile), in 3rd and Marcus James 4th followed by Ed Wray and Garth Riley rounding out the top 6.

Sunday 11th Dec is the last day of sailing for the year for the Laser fleet and will also be the first heats of the Autumn Point Score. There will be some boats not sailing due to other commitments so a good time to get a jump on them. With Garth and myself on Duty and Catering it should be a great afternoon.

As always thank you to the MYC sailing committee and especially Colin for his help with logistics with the growing fleet.




