

A MESSAGE FROM



"RMS are working with organisers on a major aquatic event planned for the **weekend of 15th and 16th February** in the waters between Sow and Pigs reef and Garden Island which has the potential to disrupt sailing and other regular harbour activities.

Exclusion zone buoy laying is likely to commence from approximately 1 or 2pm with the event planned for 4-6pm.

More location details and other information will be made available once the event has been officially launched in early October."

Your club activities or racing maybe affected so if it does, then it is best to plan accordingly and make the necessary adjustments to your program.

NOTE: This is **unlikely** to affect Marathon Race 3, scheduled for 17th February, as Australian Sailing has indicated that the event will only take place Friday and Saturday, however members should be aware of the activity when enjoying the harbour on this weekend.

ANCHORS AWAY!

Here is a timely reminder for the start of the sailing season, to stow those anchors while racing.

It will be the perfect tack or the exceptional spinnaker drop that will win you the race, **NOT** that extra 20 or 30cm protruding from your bow.

For reasons of safety, and because it's in your sailing instructions, please make sure you comply.

Otherwise, you may not like the consequences!




